

Welcome to Nowton Park

Nowton Park boasts almost 200 acres of beautiful Suffolk countryside landscaped over 100 years ago in typical Victorian style. It is owned by St Edmundsbury Borough Council and managed for recreation, leisure and nature conservation. Once part of the Oakes family estate, the park is comprised of beautiful wild flower meadows, mixed woodland, wildlife ponds and an arboretum featuring trees from around the world. The Lime Avenue with its 100,000 daffodils is a spectacular sight during the Spring. From short strolls to lengthy walks, way-marked circular paths lead you through the varied landscape, whilst the 3km off road cycle route meanders deep into the woods. Grass and artificial football pitches are available for hire.

Dogs are welcome but must be kept under control.
