Please see below some important information ahead of your visit...

Performance location and car parking

- Theatre in the Parks will be held in the Anglo-Saxon village area
- Main car park on site, please note charges apply from 9am-8pm, £3 for all day
- All performances are around two hours long, including an interval
- You are welcome to take your seats up to an hour before the performance is due to start
- Unfortunately, dogs are not permitted within the Anglo-Saxon Village area, with the exception of assistance dogs

What to bring

- Please bring chairs and blankets to sit on, the area is an open grassed area with no seating provided
- You can bring picnics and drinks with you, but please take your rubbish home with you
- The café will be open, as well as a refreshments stall, with ice-cream, drinks and snacks available
- Please come prepared for the weather, sun cream, hats, sunglasses etc

The weather

- There is natural shade covering the audience area, but do feel free to bring umbrellas, beach tents etc to provide additional cover, however you may be asked to sit a little further back with these items
- Should there be any rainfall the performance will continue unless it is unsafe to do so
